

Dedication of Doug Smith Island



On Friday, June 1st, at 10:45 AM there will be a public dedication ceremony of Doug Smith Island (formerly Bryan Island).

An Incorporator and early President of the Manchester Land Conservation Trust, Doug Smith was an active member of the Manchester Conservation Commission for many years. As Chairman of the Hockanum River Linear Park Committee, Doug led efforts to restore the Hockanum River and to create the many miles of hiking trails that are now along its banks, including those on Doug Smith Island.

Doug Smith Island is in the Hockanum River in Manchester directly behind Kohl's Department Store on Tolland Turnpike. Parking for the ceremony is available in the northeast corner of Kohl's parking lot.
